Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.176 dated 29.11.2021, under Sections 323, 506 of IPC, Section 75 JJ Act and Section 8 of POCSO Act (added later on), registered at Police Station Women Jind, District Jind.

By virtue of the order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Geeta has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.01.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
