The present appeal has been filed against the judgment and decree dated 16.12.2019 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court at Sonipat, whereby the petition filed by the respondent-husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 for dissolution of marriage, has been allowed.

The parties solemnized marriage on 30.11.2013 according to Hindu rites and ceremonies at Jain Bagh Colony, Sonipat. Out of this wedlock, one male child, namely, Viyan, was born. On account of temperamental differences, they started living separately.

Both the parties are present in Court today and stated that they have compromised the matter and they are staying together happily for the last one year. Statements of both the parties to this effect have been recorded in Court today and the respondent has no objection if the present

appeal is allowed judgment and decree dated 16.12.2019 is set aside.

In view of the fact that the parties are residing together happily from the last one year, the instant appeal is allowed and judgment and decree 16.12.2019 passed by the learned Principal Judge, Family Court at Sonipat, is set aside. However, the parties shall remain bound by their respective statements dated 19.12.2022.

Since the main appeal stands allowed, civil misc. applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
