On 25.01.2022, this Court passed the following order:-

“Heard through video conferencing.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.0539 dated 29.12.2021, registered for offences under Sections 323, 34, 354-B, 506 and 509 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Pinjore, District Panchkula.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that FIR is the counter-blast to the complaint given by the petitioner along with other members of a society against father of the complainant regarding the misuse of the premises located in the temple. He submits that the complainant had alleged that seven accused had attacked her father, dragged and slapped her and the petitioner is alleged to have molested her, which allegation is absolutely false. Counsel submits that most of the co-accused

have been granted interim bail by the Sessions Court and the petitioner is ready to join the investigation and co-operate with the Investigating Agency.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Punjab (sic. Haryana) accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

List on 05.04.2022.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would appear as and when called for by the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, he shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. He shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Upon instructions from L/PSI Pooja, State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation, is no longer required for custodial interrogation and final report under Section 173 of Cr.P.C. has been prepared.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 25.01.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
