The petitioners are seeking a direction to the respondents to regularise their services.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has drawn my attention to the legal notice dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-11) and contends that he would be satisfied if a direction is given to the respondents to decide the same in a time bound manner. He has relied upon the judgments of the Coordinate Bench of this Court in similar cases bearing CWP Nos. 11106 of 2021, 24883 of 2021 and 26406 of 2021, annexed at Annexures P-8, P-9 and P-10, respectively, wherein directions to decide legal notice have been issued.

Issue notice to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of the court, Mr. Nikhil Chopra, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Heard.

Without expressing anything on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 2 to consider and decide the legal notice dated 12.11.2021 (Annexure P-11), in accordance with law, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
