Petitioners have filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.69 dated 19.06.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana and subsequent proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise.

Vide order dated 20.01.2020, parties were directed to appear before concerned Trial Court/Illaq Magistrate for getting their statements recorded and the trial Court was to send its report regarding the genuineness of the compromise.

A report dated 10.02.2020 of learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal has been received. As per the report, the parties had appeared before learned Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Payal. Learned Magistrate has stated the compromise is genuine, without any undue influence, coercion or pressure.

In view thereof, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.69 dated 19.06.2018, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, are hereby quashed qua the petitioners.
