Learned State counsel submits that matter is pending before the trial Court for 25th December, 2022. Prosecution evidence is completed and statement under Section 313 Cr.P.C. has been recorded.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner was seeking transfer of the case alleging that the Judicial Officer Mr. Sunil Kumar, JMIC, Assand has made an observations that petitioner is a habitual offender.

From the *zimni* order dated 13th May, 2022 produced, it is evident that case is no longer fixed before the same Judicial Officer.

In view of the above, no further directions are called for, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.

It is clarified that this Court has made no observations on the allegations made by the petitioner.
