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VIVEK PURI, J. (ORAL)

Petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No. 54 dated 20.03.2019 under Sections 376, 506, 380 IPC, registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at the earlier instance the matter was amicably settled and respondent No.2 had agreed for quashing of FIR. However, subsequently respondent No.2 has resiled from the compromise and, consequently, the present FIR cannot be quashed on the basis of compromise.

Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought to withdraw the present petition seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of compromise with liberty to seek alternative remedy to quash the FIR on merits as may be available under law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
