AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition was filed seeking directions to the official respondents to conduct fair investigation in FIR No. 0019 dated 01.03.2019., under Sections 420, 120-B IPC at Police Station Sadar Sri Muktsar Sahib.

The State filed status report dated 18.2.2021. The relevant paragraph No. 10 is quoted hereinbelow:-

“10. In my view there is insufficient evidence to implicate Rajwant Singh in the present case, it is further pertinent to mention herewith that a SIT under the Chairmanship of Superintendent of Police (Investigation) Sri Muktsar Sahib is still investigating the present case who is looking into any evidence that can be collected against Rajwant Singh who should be thoroughly examined for the transactions undertaken by him with the amount of Rupees Sixty Lacs given by Davinder Singh to establish any misappropriation by him. I have not found any role of his wife Gurmeet Kaur in the said transactions. It should also be examined

as to whether any investments have been made by Rajwant Singh into the Bhaddal College of Engineering and Technology being the present Chairman of the college or of any transactions made by Rajwant Singh into the Perth College of Business and Technology, Australia out of the sum of sixty lacs. As of now Rajwant Singh has claimed that he has sold off his stake in the said college and is no longer a director in the Australian institute.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in spite of constituting the SIT the grievance still survives.

SIT was constituted, no further directions were called for by this Court, the present petition is disposed of.

Needless to say that petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of the surviving grievance, if any.
