This is the second petition filed under Section 482 read with 439 of the Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.148 dated 07.07.2020, under Sections 21 & 22 of the NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Shahzadpur, District Ambala.

On 02.02.2022, it was pointed out by the learned State counsel that the petitioner was granted interim bail by this Court vide Annexure P-3, in view of the judgment passed by the Division Bench of this Court in ***“Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi and others Vs. State of Punjab”***, 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 953, but he has not surrendered. On that date, the learned counsel for the petitioner stated that he has sought instructions from the petitioner that he will surrender prior to the next date of hearing and the matter was adjourned to 04.03.2022.

However on 04.03.2022, he again sought time to appear and surrender before the trial Court on the date already fixed i.e. 01.04.2022 and it was on the basis of the undertaking given by the learned counsel for the petitioner that the matter was adjourned to 05.04.2022 i.e. today.

Today again, the learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has failed to surrender.

In view of the above, the present petition stands dismissed.

However, anything observed hereinabove shall not be treated as an expression of opinion on merits of the case and is only meant for the purpose of decision of present petition.
