The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

Through the present petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner seeks release of Neha, who he claims to be his wife, from the alleged illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 6, who are Neha's parents and uncle.

On 19.01.2022, while issuing notice, this Court had appointed a Warrant Officer, who after visiting the residence of respondents No.4 to 6 has filed a report in a sealed cover which was opened and as per which, the Warrant Officer found Neha in the house of respondents No.4 to 6. On being questioned she told the Warrant Officer that she would like to go to the petitioner only with the consent of her parents and that too after marriage. In this regard a note in Neha's own hand and duly signed by her is

also found attached with the report of the Warrant Officer.

In the light of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
