Main Case

The petitioner-appellant is aggrieved against the judgement

dated 20.12.2011, passed by the Rent Controller, Moga, whereby his petition under Section 13(B) of the Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949 for ejectment of respondents No.1 to 7 was dismissed.

Learned counsel states that the present revision petition was filed by petitioner-Bakhtawar Singh through General Power of Attorney, namely, Gurdeep Singh Gill, but during the pendency of the same, both of them expired, and the present application has been filed on behalf of sons of Bakhtawar Singh, namely, Balwinder Singh and Harjit Singh through their Special Power of Attorney, namely, Pritpal Singh.

Learned counsel has further stated that as the sons of Bakhtawar Singh have filed a fresh petition under Section 13(B) of the East Punjab Urban Rent Restriction Act, 1949, therefore, he has instructions to withdraw this petition.

Learned counsel for respondents No.2, 3 and 5 to 7 does not oppose the same and states that he has no objection, if, the revision petition is allowed to be withdrawn.

The petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
