Through this petition, petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr. P. C., in case FIR No. 273 dated 14.09.2022 under Sections 420, 467, 468 and 471 IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 13-17, Panipat.

Vide order dated 16.03.2022 passed by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 16.03.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Per contra, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 16.03.2022 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
