**MEENAKSHI I. MEHTA, J.(Oral)**

At the very outset, learned Senior counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition while submitting that the Challan has not yet been presented in the Court in connection with the FIR in question and therefore, the petitioners would be moving a fresh petition for seeking the same relief as claimed in this petition, as and when the same would become permissible to them under law.

Ms. Ishneet Kaur, learned Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondent No.1-State in this case in pursuance of the copy of the instant petition having been sent to this respondent in advance, has no objection for the same.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn. However, the petitioners will be at liberty to move a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in this petition, as and when and if at all, it would become legally permissible to them.
