The petitioner has filed this petition under Articles 226 & 227 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned award dated 26.07.2018, Annexure P-2 passed by respondent No.1 directing reinstatement of the respondent No.2-workman on the same post with continuity in service with full back wages from the date demand notice dated 08.12.2016 and all other consequential benefits; along with certain other prayers.

The counsel for respondent No.2 has pointed out that for challenging the same award dated 26.07.2018 another writ petition, i.e.

CWP No. 26431 of 2018, is already pending before this court. In that case, notice of motion has been issued and the same is now pending for 21.03.2022.

In view of the above, the second petition for the same cause of action is not maintainable. Accordingly, the petition stands dismissed.

However, the dismissal of the present petition would not be taken as adverse to the petitioner in the earlier writ petition. The same shall be considered and decided as per its own merits.

All the pending applications, if any, stand disposed of accordingly.
