1. In the instant petition the petitioner seeks the making of a mandamus, upon the official respondents concerned, to provide adequate protection, and, security to the co-petitioners, as the private respondents arrayed as co-respondents Nos.4 to 11, are meteing threats to co-petitioner No.1, as well as to her minor daughter one Rasleen Kaur, who is staying alongwith co-petitioner No.1.

2. Though, at this Stage, no tangible evidence is placed on record, in respect of the gravity of the afore meted alleged threats to the co-petitioners, by the afore respondents, nor is there any tangible evidence on record in support of the afore threats becoming potentialized.

3. However, in the larger interest of justice, it is deemed fit, and, appropriate to make a direction upon the co-respondent Nos.2 and 3 to, in accordance with law, and, after granting an opportunity of hearing to all

concerned, to decide through speaking order, and, within three weeks hereafter the representation of the co-petitioners, as is embodied in Annexure P-1.
