This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking regular bail in case of FIR No. 220 dated 8.9.2021, under Sections 307, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC, Section 27 of Arms Act and Section 3 of SC&ST Act, registered at Police Station Bhuna, District Fatehabad.

The FIR was recorded on the statement of Sandeep Kaur. As per the allegations on 8.9.2021 at about 10:30 a.m., she heard noises of fight in the street and on coming out, she saw that Subhash, Sonu (petitioner) and Bablu along with six-seven others persons were beating her husband. Petitioner exhorted Subhash by uttering caste based remarks and Subhash fired bullet from the revolver, which hit her husband in the chest and other shot fired hit thigh of right leg of the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no specific injury is attributed to the petitioner. Petitioner is in custody since 9.9.2021. Prosecution is intentionally delaying the trial.

Learned State counsel opposes the prayer and submits that victims are from Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes. The complainant and injured are yet to be examined. Trial is at initial stage. If the petitioner is granted bail, he would be in a position to influence the evidence.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to approach the Sessions Court latter in case of change in circumstance.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
