Due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, the instant case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The petitioner has invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to count the period of work charge service of the petitioner from 10.10.1968 to 25.05.1977 for the purpose of his pensionary benefits.

Upon hearing counsel for the petitioner and on

perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 04.12.2019 (Annexure P-1) and dated 21.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) moved by the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the relief, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
