1. Learned counsel representing the petitioner is not present.
2. Ms. Mona Goyal, learned counsel appears for the respondents (landlord) and submit that the appeal filed by the tenant before the First Appellate Court has been withdrawn.
3. This revision petition was filed assailing the correctness of order passed by the appellate authority while directing the tenant to pay mesne profits @Rs.20,000/- per month.
4. Learned counsel representing the respondents submits that since the main appeal has been withdrawn, therefore, the revision petition is rendered infructuous. She has also placed on record the certified copy of the order dated 08.02.2021 and the same is taken on record.
5. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is dismissed as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to file an application for revival, if the facts are otherwise.
