Present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 214 dated 18.11.2020, under Sections 457 and 380 IPC (Sections 411 and 201 IPC added later on) registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur.

Vide order dated 07.02.2022, this Court while granting the concession of interim anticipatory bail directed the petitioner to join investigation.

On instructions, learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his custodial interrogation is no longer required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 07.02.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is

made absolute. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions of Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
