Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.237 dated 06.12.2021, under Sections 363, 366-A of IPC (Section 120-B IPC was added later on), registered at Police Station Baghapurana, District Moga.

By virtue of the order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that challan stands presented and petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.01.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
