[1] Prayer in thepetition is for initiation of proceedings against the respondent(s) for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 24.01.2019, in CWP No.24255 of 2015 in case titled as '**Balbir Gulshan Gupta**versus**State of Punjab and another**'.

[2] A perusal of order Annexure (P-1) reveals that CWP No.24255 of 2015 was allowed and the respondents were directed to fix the pension of the petitioner in the pay band of Rs.37400-67000 + AGP of Rs.9000/- w.e.f. 01.01.2006, with calculation of the revised pension to be done within 02 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order besides the petitioner was held entitled to arrears for a period of 03 years and 02 months from the date of filing of the writ petition.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that benefits as per entitlement in terms of order (Annexure P-1) have been released to the petitioner, therefore, in the circumstances, the petitioner is

withdraw the same.

[4] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
