LISA GILL, J.

This revision petition has been filed for setting aside order dated 29.04.2016 (Annexure P-7), passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Hisar, whereby application filed by the petitioner under Section 8 read with Section 5 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, has been dismissed.

Notice of motion was issued in this petition, though no interim relief was afforded. Perusal of the file shows that on the last date of hearing when this matter was taken up, none had appeared on account of work being suspended by the Bar Association of this High Court. Today none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. However, learned counsel for respondent no.1 submits that this revision petition is rendered infructuous as the civil suit filed by respondent no.1 has since been decreed and appeal filed by the present petitioner is pending.

In this view of the matter, I do not find any justification in keeping this matter pending any longer. Revision petition is accordingly dismissed. Liberty is afforded to the petitioner to file an appropriate application, within four weeks, in case of any inaccuracy in the factual position as above.
