Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.88 dated 16.11.2021, under Sections 406, 498-A and 506 of IPC, registered at Police Station Women, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 24.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated. He submits that the parties were appeared before the Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court but the mediation remained unsuccessful. He further submits that the petitioner had already paid Rs.25000/- as the litigation expenses to the complainant as directed by this court.

has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant vehemently opposes the contentions of learned counsel for the petitioner and submits that some of the dowry articles remains to be recovered from the petitioner.

In these circumstances, the Court finds that the matter deserves to be decided on merits.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 24.01.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
