The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India praying for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari; quashing order dated 13.01.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by the District Magistrate-cum-Chairman, Appellate Tribunal, Karnal-respondent No. 1, whereby the application filed by the petitioner under the Parents and Senior Citizens Maintenance and Welfare Act, 2007 for eviction of the respondents has been dismissed.

Perusal of the order impugned shows that the application filed by the petitioner under Sections 22 and 23 of the Parents and Senior Citizens Maintenance and Welfare Act, 2007 has been declined on the ground that the petitioner has failed to substantiate his claim qua title of the property in question. Since the petitioner has failed to show his title, therefore, the statutory authority has not committed any illegality in dismissing the application as such.

Hence finding no merit in the writ petition, the same is dismissed.
