Mr. Rajeev Anand, PP for UT Chandigarh, accepts notice and waives service on behalf of the respondents. On instructions from ASI Satish Kumar, learned State counsel submits that the challan is almost ready and except for recording of the statement of maternal uncle of the petitioner, as on date the file is pending with the District Attorney.

Given above, counsel for the petitioner to ensure that maternal uncle appears before the Investigator and record the statement and help in the inquiry.

At this stage, learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner argues that the concerned maternal uncle lives abroad and as such his statement be recorded through video conferencing and on this argument, learned State counsel has no objection.

Learned counsel for the petitioner shall also convey to the concerned maternal uncle to attend that meeting. It is clarified that in case, for any reason the maternal uncle is not connected, then the challan shall be filed without waiting for him, within 10 days from today.

Petition is disposed of in the terms mentioned above and liberty is reserved for the petitioner to approach this Court again, if need arises.
