Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.02 dated 02.01.2020, under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that FIR is outcome of a monetary dispute which has now been settled through Mediation. A copy of the settlement dated 25.01.2022 is taken on record.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 16.08.2021 had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Chand Amir, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 16.08.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.

The parties shall adhere to the terms of the settlement.
