The present is the second bail application (although stated as third bail application) seeking regular bail to the petitioner.

The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the earlier bail application was dismissed as withdrawn at that stage on 26.11.2021 vide Annexure P-2. He submitted that since the proceeding before the trial Court is not going on, the petitioner may be considered for the grant of regular bail.

On the other hand, Mr. Dhruv Dayal, learned Sr. Deputy A.G., Punjab has taken a preliminary objection by stating that the present petition is not maintainable in view of the fact that the earlier bail application was dismissed on 26.11.2021 and the present bail application has been filed on 20.1.2022 which was even less than two months and

there is no change of circumstance and, therefore, the present petition is not maintainable.

I have heard the learned counsels for the parties.

The earlier bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed as withdrawn on 26.11.2021 vide Annexure P-2 and after a period of less than two months, the petitioner filed another bail application on 20.1.2022 without giving any reason regarding change of circumstance.

In view of the above, the present petition is, hereby, dismissed.
