After arguing for a while, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, while submitting that as regards the registration of the FIR against private respondents No.3 to 7, the petitioner shall be availing the appropriate efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to him under law, for this purpose and so far as the relief qua the protection of his life and liberty is concerned, the petitioner shall be moving a fresh representation to respondent No.1-Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, exclusively praying therein for the said protection only and he further prays that respondent No.1 be directed to look into and take appropriate action on his representation within some specific time frame.

Mr. Shashank Bhandari, learned Additional Public Prosecutor,
U.T, Chandigarh, who has joined the proceedings on behalf of respondents

No.1 and 2 in pursuance of the copies of the instant petition having been sent to the respondent-U.T in advance, has no objection to the above-discussed submission as well as the prayer as made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn with a direction to respondent No.1 that in case the petitioner moves any fresh representation to him restricting his prayer therein for the protection of his life and liberty only, he shall look into the same and if the petitioner would be found to be genuinely deserving the afore-said protection, then he shall take appropriate action, strictly in accordance with law, in the given set of facts and circumstances of the matter, preferably within a period of ten days.
