Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and his family members at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the son of the petitioner has gone missing with the daughter of respondent No.4, even though both of them are major, and therefore, there is a constant threat to the petitioner and his family members at the hands of the private respondents. The petitioner has also moved a representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, for redressal of his grievance, but the same has yielded no result.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer to the issuance of direction to respondent No.2 to decide the said

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representation within a stipulated period.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner during the course of hearing, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Amritsar Rural, to decide the representation dated 18.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) moved by the petitioner, within a period of one month after receiving the certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
