The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the daily wage service rendered by the petitioner as qualifying service and accordingly fix his pension and other retiral benefits and with a further direction that all arrears may be ordered to be paid to the petitioner along with interest @ 12% p.a., as well as to decide the representation dated 13.10.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to

the respondents to consider the representation dated 13.10.2021 (Annexure P3) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
