AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed for quashing of F.I.R. No.53, dated 2.9.2019, under Sections 380-120-B, IPC (45 of 1860) IPC registered at P.S. Smalsar, District Moga and all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom in view of compromise deed dated 17.12.2019.

The parties were directed to get their statements recorded with regard to the compromise.

On the last date none had put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner and complainant. Even today, petitioner and complainant are unrepresented.

Learned counsel for the State has produced an order dated 29.10.2020 whereby the cancellation report has been accepted by the Illaqa Magistrate, Baghapurana.

In view of the order produced, no cause of action survives, the petition is disposed of as infructuous.

for moving an application for revival of the petition.
