[1] Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P-1, dated 28.08.2020, in CWP No.13010 of 2020.

[2] A perusal of order (Annexure P-1), reveals that CWP No.13010 of 2020, was disposed of by directing the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in legal notice dated 26.05.2020 within 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

[3] Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents refers to Annexure R-2/1 attached to the reply filed by way of affidavit of *Shri Ravinder Garg, Executive Officer, Improvement Trust, Bathinda* and states that in view of the claim of the petitioner having been decided and payment as per entitlement determined made to the petitioner, the

instant petition be disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

[4] Learned counsel for the petitioner on the other hand contends that in view of payment having been made to the petitioner, he does not press the instant petition but prays for liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-2/1) to the extent the same denies grant of interest on the delayed payment.

[5] In view of the position noted above, as well as statement of learned counsel for the parties, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while granting liberty to the petitioner as prayed for.
