This is an application filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for preponement of the date of hearing in the main case from 21.04.2022 to an early date.

Learned counsel for the applicant-petitioner has submitted that the petitioner wishes to withdraw the main petition as he has been granted the benefit of suspension of sentence.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab,

appears and accepts notice on behalf of the non-applicant/State of Punjab and has submitted that he has no objection in case the present application is allowed and the date of hearing in the main case is preponed from 21.04.2022 to today itself for final disposal.

In view of the aforesaid facts and no objection from the opposite side, the present application is allowed and the main petition is taken on Board today itself for final disposal.

Main case

This is second Criminal Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ for quashing of impugned order/letter dated 10.05.2021 (Annexure P-2) passed by respondent No.2, whereby application for grant of six weeks parole to the petitioner was rejected without considering the provisions of the Punjab Good Conduct of Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present Criminal Writ Petition.

In view of the above, the present Criminal Writ Petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
