Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for quashing/setting aside the order dated 10.02.2020 passed by the Addl. Sessions Judge, Amritsar in BA No.6624 of 2019 and BA No.414 of 2020 in case titled as 'State Vs. Rajbir Singh @ Veeru' bearing FIR No.129 dated 05.06.2019 under Section 21 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Lopoke, Amritsar Rural, whereby the petitioner had been declined the extension of time for furnishing bail bonds before the trial Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 27.01.2021, the petitioner had surrendered before the trial Court and was released on interim bail. It is further contended that the petitioner has been appearing on each and every date fixed by the trial Court.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 27.01.2021 is, hereby, made absolute.
