PUNJAB AND HARYANA HIGH COURT CHANDIGARH**

On request, the instant matter taken up in Bi-monthly Lok Adalat, accordingly discussed.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants and learned counsel for the Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹3,50,000/- (₹ Three Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to appellant Nos.1 and 4 to supply their Bank Account Numbers to respondent No.3 – Bajaj Allianz General Insurance Company Limited within one week from today. Pursuant thereto, Insurance Company will deposit the agreed amount in the Bank Accounts of appellant Nos.1 and 4 within three weeks thereafter in proportion as already awarded by MACT. In case of failure to provide the Bank details by appellant Nos.1 and 4, the Insurance Company shall deposit crossed-cheques for ₹3,50,000/- in the name of appellant Nos.1 and 4 - Smt.Gurmeet Kaur widow of Amritpal Singh @ Raju and Salochna Devi wife of Bahadur Singh @ Bader Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of one month, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this

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amount till payment from the date of this order. The amount of share of minor appellants shall be deposited in a nationalized Bank in the name of the minor appellants in shape of FDR and they shall be entitled to encash/refund the same on attaining majority. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques and FDRs to learned counsel/representative of the respondent - Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
