Petitioner has preferred this criminal writ petition under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus by way of directions to respondent Nos.2 to 4 to protect his life and liberty and further to renew his passport.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that vide order dated 16.04.2014 (Annexure P-6), the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No.31 dated 28.04.2013 under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station City Banga, District SBS Nagar and his petition to challenge the said order has been dismissed by this Court, and presently also the petitioner is abroad. On the issue of maintainability of the prayer for issuance of directions to protect the life and liberty, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the same.

When confronted with the maintainability of the other prayer for renewal of his passport, he prays for withdrawal of this petition in order to file appropriate petition on the same cause of action.

The prayer is accepted.

The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
