The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.291 dated 26.8.2021 registered under Sections 498-A, 406, 377, 376, 511, 342, 354, 506, 34 IPC, sections 8, 12 of POCSO Act and sections 9, 10 and 11 of Prohibition of Child Marriage Act at Police Station IMT, Rohtak.

By virtue of the order dated 9.5.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 9.5.2022, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. It is further submitted that parties have amicably resolved their dispute before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this court.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has affirmed the submissions made by counsel for petitioner.

In view of the above, the order dated 9.5.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C and the petition stands allowed.
