**JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.(ORAL)**

The prayer under Section 438 Cr.PC is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.48 dated 5.08.2021 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Talwandi Bhai, District Ferozepur.

Vide order dated 08.03.2022 the petitioner was asked to join investigation. Pursuant to which she has joined investigation. However, the counsel for the State on instructions from ASI Amarjeet Singh submits that though she has joined investigation but she has not co-operated in the same.

Be that as it may, the dispute between the parties appears to be of civil in nature and the complainant has not filed any suit for specific performance of the contract. In fact the Civil Suit filed was for injunction and the same also stands withdrawn.

In view of the above, no case for custodial interrogation is

made out.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 08.03.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
