JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C., seeking quashing of FIR No.0155 dated 07.08.2020, under Section 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Area (Annexure P-1), and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he has stolen a wrist watch of make Diesel worth Rs.25,995/- from the store of respondent No.2.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that they have compromised the matter and they have no grievance against the petitioner. They do not want to pursue their complaint and have no objection if the impugned FIR is quashed.

Learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh submits that she has no objection if the present petition is allowed.

In view of the compromise arrived at between the contesting parties and statement of learned counsel for U.T.Chandigarh, the present petition is allowed. FIR No.0155 dated 07.08.2020, under Section 380 of IPC, registered at Police Station Industrial Area (Annexure P-1) and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom are quashed qua the petitioner(s).
