JASJIT SINGH BEDI, J.(ORAL)

The present petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.PC has been filed for seeking appropriate directions to respondent nos.2 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the Petitioner and his family members.

The Counsel for the petitioner contends that he was the complainant in case FIR No.291 dated 02.12.2021 under Section 302, 120-B IPC registered against the present respondents. He contends that he is facing a threat to his life and liberty and he is being forced to effect a compromise.

The Counsel for the State on the other hand contends that after the investigation, a cancellation report has been submitted on 14.03.2022

which is pending adjudication. The petitioner was not found to be facing any threat from the private respondents.

The Counsel for the private respondents on the other hand has filed his power of attorney and contends that there is absolutely nothing to suggest that the private respondents are harassing the petitioner in any manner. He further submits that in fact the son of the petitioner was facing trial in case FIR No.223 of 2019 under Section 354, 323, 506 and 34 IPC, in which the respondent no.8 was a witness. He thus contends that the respondents have been falsely implicated in the present FIR.

In view of the respective contentions of all the parties, no orders are required to be passed by this court in this petition. However, in case the petitioner still faces any threat, he is free to approach the authorities concerned, who shall proceed in accordance with law.

Disposed of in the above terms.
