**ANIL KSHETARPAL, J(Oral)**

The prayer in the petition is to set aside the order passed by the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Malout, refusing to club the land situated in khewat no.19 in the partition application filed for the partition of land comprised in khewat no.18. The private respondent filed an application seeking partition of the joint land comprised in khewat no.18. The petitioners objected to its maintainability on the ground that the land comprised in khewat no.19 has not been included. The Assistant Collector Ist Grade has found that the co-owners in khewat no.19 are different, though, some of the co-owners in khewat no.18 and 19 are common.

Admittedly, there is no separate application filed for the partition of the land comprised in khewat no.19. As and when such application is filed, the Assistant Collector will examine the feasibility of clubbing both the partition proceedings in the interest of the consolidation of holdings. However, in the absence of the separate application for the

partition of khewat no.19, the Assistant Collector was correct in dismissing the same.

Hence, no ground to interfere is made out.

Dismissed.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
