On 07.11.2022, the following order was passed:-

“Despite the repeated opportunities, learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to provide the correct address of the respondent to enable the office to issue notice to him as directed on 04.08.2016. On August 01, 2022, on the prayer of the learned counsel representing the petitioner, the case was adjourned to enable him to take necessary steps in this regard. However, as per the office report, the learned counsel representing the petitioner has failed to furnish the correct address of the respondent.

This revision petition is pending for the last 6 years. Although, there is no justification, however, in the interest of justice, one last opportunity is granted to the learned counsel to furnish the correct address of the respondent, within a period of next three working days, upon which notice be issued to the respondent for 21.11.2022.

It is made clear that if the needful is not done within the stipulated period, the revision petition shall be deemed to have been dismissed for non-prosecution, without further reference to the Court. To be listed in the urgent list.”

The learned counsel representing the petitioner has informed the court that the petitioner, despite his best efforts, has failed to connect with the petitioner.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
