Status report by way of affidavit of Mukesh Kumar, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Kosli, District Rewari has been filed today in the Court, the same is taken on record.

Petitioner has preferred the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.72 dated 05.05.2020, under Sections 323, 325, 498-A, 313, 506 and 34 of IPC and (Section 313 of IPC was added later on) , registered at Police Station Rohadai, District Rewari.

By virtue of the order dated 28.01.2022, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation. It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that the petitioner has joined the

investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Poonam has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

Learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the submissions made by leaned counsel for the petitioner.

In view of the above, the interim order dated 28.01.2022, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
