In this Writ Petition the petitioner contends that the petitioner is eligible for grant of benefit under Credit Guarantee Scheme for Subordinate Debt (CGSSD) Scheme floated by the Reserve Bank of India; and though the petitioner has made a request for the said benefit vide letter dt.30.12.2021 to respondent No.4, and vide letter dt. 03.01.2022 with the respondent No.3, but they have not taken any action thereon.

Notice of motion.

Mr. S.S.Pannu, Sr. DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State, and Mr. Sanjeev Gupta, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.4.

Mr. Sanjeev Gupta, Advocate states that certain documents are required to be submitted by the petitioner for claiming benefits of the said Scheme and respondent No.4 has addressed the letter on 31.01.2022 to the petitioner to supply the required documents to respondent No.4 to consider

whether or not the petitioner is eligible under the said Scheme. Copy of the said

letter be supplied to the counsel for the petitioner within two days by counsel for respondent No.4.

Subject to the petitioner submitting the required documents pointed out in the letter dt.31.01.2022 to respondent No.4, respondents No. 3 and 4 are directed to consider the representations dt.31.12.2021 and 03.01.2022 submitted by the petitioner for extending benefit of the Credit Guarantee Scheme for Subordinate Debt (CGSSD) within 4 weeks and inform the petitioner of their decision in that regard.
