Writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution, *inter alia*, for issuance of direction to the respondents to appoint the petitioner on the post of Science Mistress in pursuance of advertisement dated 28.02.2020 (P-1).

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that instead of pressing the writ petition on merits at this stage, his client would be satisfied, in case, representation dated 16.09.2021 (P-11) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to that limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

adjudicating the controversy on merits, writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.1-Secretary, School Education, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 16.09.2021 (P-11), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
