Petitioner is seeking issuance of directions for fair and impartial investigation in the case bearing FIR No. 837 dated 10.12.2021 under Sections 304-B, 34 IPC and 302 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Old Industrial Area Panipat, District Panipat.

Status report by way of affidavit of Om Parkash, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Crime against Women, Panipat on behalf of the respondents has been taken on record.

Learned State counsel contends that during the course of investigation, it had emerged that it was a case of death due to asphyxia secondary to constriction of neck structure as a result of ligature strangulation. It had also emerged that on the apprehension that the deceased was having some extra marital relationship, her husband namely Shankar along with his servant Monu had committed her murder by strangulation. Rajender, Shakuntla, Ravi and Sonia were found innocent and were having no role in the commission of crime. Accordingly, there

names have been deleted. After fair, proper, thorough, deep and impartial investigation, the report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been submitted against Shankar and Monu after effecting their arrest.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has sought to withdraw the present petition with liberty to seek alternative remedy as may be available during the course of trial in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
