Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case bearing FIR No.0140 dated 08.12.2021 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 324, 506, 148, 149 IPC and later on added Section 326 IPC registered at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 31.01.2022 passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Balbir Singh submits that the petitioner has joined investigation in terms of orders dated 31.01.2022 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In this view of the matter, interim order dated 31.01.2022 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
