By means of this petition, the petitioner seeks issuance of writ in the nature of habeas corpus for release of his daughter, who is stated to be in illegal custody of respondent No.4.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has argued that his daughter, namely, Babita had gone with Sagar Gupta without giving any information and in this regard, he gave a complaint to the police, whereupon DDR No.57 dated 17.01.2022 (Annexure P-1) was recorded. He submits that necessary directions be issued for release of detainee from illegal detention of respondent No.4.

At this stage, Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, Add.PP, U.T.Chandigarh, learned counsel appearing on behalf U.T.Chandigarh, has joined the proceedings on advance notice and on instructions from SI Ram Dahyia has stated that daughter of the petitioner has entered

into marriage with respondent No.4. She has produced the copy of the marriage certificate. She has further stated that though a petition has been filed by daughter of the petitioner for protection before this Court along with respondent No.4, but the same is yet to be listed.

Considering the above background, particularly the stand of the petitioner himself, who has stated that his daughter voluntarily went with Sagar Gupta, no case is made out for exercise of extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
