In the present writ petition, the prayer of the petitioner is that he should be granted benefit of compassionate pension keeping in view the fact that the petitioner had rendered 22 years of service with the respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after notice of motion, the respondents have not filed reply, which is causing prejudice to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner had already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P/7), which is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to the respondent No.2 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Mann, Addl. A.G. Haryana, who is present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P/7) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in his representation, respondent No.2 is directed to decide the representation dated 18.10.2020 (Annexure P/7) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

Present writ petition stands disposed of.
