1. Prayer in the petition is fortaking action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.08.2018, in CWP-19029-2018.

2. A perusal of order, Annexure P/1 dated 02.08.2018, reveals that CWP-19029-2018, was disposed of by directing the Punjab State Power Corporation through its Chairman-cum-Managing Director, to look into the grievance as contained in legal notice dated 12.04.2018 and take a conscious decision in respect thereto by passing a speaking order, in accordance with law, within three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

3. Learned counsel contends that although the instant petition was filed on account of failure of the respondents to do the needful but now the respondents have complied with order dated 02.08.2018 and decided the claim made in the legal notice, therefore, the petitioner does

not press the instant petition.

4. Accordingly, in view of the position noted above as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.
